There are a number of ways to do this: (1) Just start by talking with family and friends – and maybe taking copies the 2010 11th LD Endorsement List around your neighborhood or precinct (we've provided the list from our June meeting in this newsletter); (2) Look for ways to support a specific candidate or ballot issue by volunteering to work on the phone bank or canvass neighborhoods that need to hear more; (3) Get involved in our 11th LD community outreach efforts – where we participate in parades and set up information booths at festivals to help inform citizens and voters; (4) Bring a friend to one of our meetings or our annual picnic – where you meet candidates and elected officials in person and get straight answers on issues that concern you; and (5) Join the Get Out The Vote efforts as we approach the primary and ultimately, election day.

All of these activities are vital this year, because political awareness tapers off in general during the years between the Presidential elections. Actually, there are a number of key national-level races this year regarding US Congressional positions. We need **high voter participation** to help us keep our experienced people in office – and replace ineffective "Party of No" officials with Democrats who will get things done! Democrats on our Congressional Delegation have worked hard for years to help our state regain prominence on powerful committees and advocated our values into new laws and funding for the right programs. We do not want that to slip away and take second-seat to other states. We do not want to give up any hard-won ground. This is worth fighting for; something we need to protect! Make sure you stay informed and vote. Make sure you help inform others and encourage them to vote.
